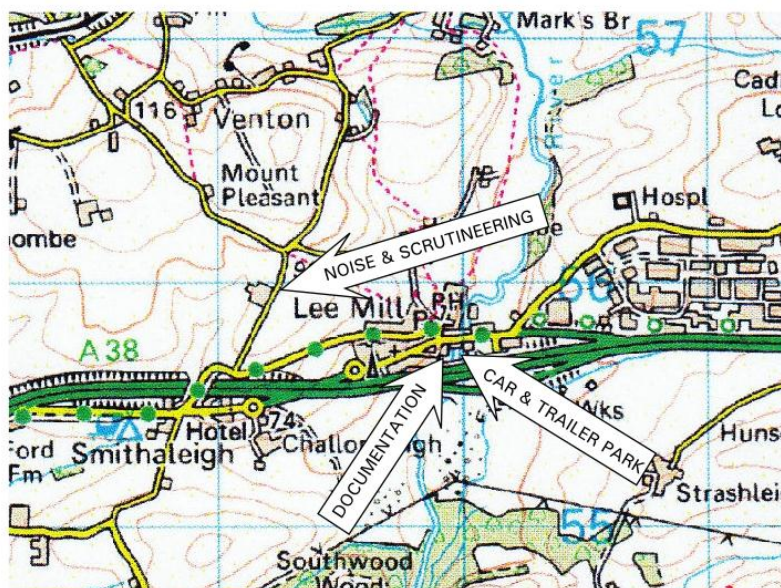

15. Types of Control or Check:

Lateness Time Control (LTC): A manned control established to record the time of a Competitor who must come to a stop for the purpose. All lost time can be recovered at any of these controls without penalty as long as you do not book into the control ahead of your due time. It can additionally record the direction of approach and departure of the Competitor.
